

Contributing to Super Fact Sheet



CBH Super can accept contributions to your account from a number of sources. This guide advises how to make the contributions and any forms you will need to complete (available from our website www.cbhsuper.com.au → Documents and Forms menu → Forms – Super).

Age restrictions for contributions

If you are aged 65 or over, you will need to complete a “*Work Test Declaration*” form to confirm that you are eligible to make contributions to superannuation. This form needs to be completed each year you make contributions after reaching age 65.

How to make contributions

Payment can be made by cheque or EFT, or for company contributions, through SuperStream.

Cheque payments: Please have your cheque payable to “CBH Superannuation Fund” and send to GPO Box L886 PERTH WA 6842.

Types of contributions

Personal deductible contributions

These are contributions made by members where they will be claiming a tax deduction for the contribution amount on their individual tax return. You will need to complete a “*Notice of intent to claim or vary a deduction for personal super contributions*” form (available on our website).

Personal after-tax contributions (Non-concessional contributions)

The contributions are made from after-tax income, but no tax deduction has been claimed for them. If you meet the income and age eligibility requirements, you may be eligible for a co-contribution from the government if you have made a non-concessional contribution.

Employer (including salary sacrifice) contributions

If you have an employer who needs to make contributions for you, the details they will need to make contributions are:
