FINANCIAL YEAR TO DATE RETURNS

The Fund's returns* (based on the change in unit price) for the period 1 July 2016 – 31 May 2017 are:

Growth MySuper option	6.85%
Balanced option	9.51%
Pension Growth option	5.37%
Pension Balanced option	9.54%
Pension Cash option	1.29%

End of financial year returns will be available upon completion of the Fund's annual audit in September 17.

* The return on your account may vary depending on when you joined the Fund, timing of any contributions and withdrawals paid to or from your account during the period.
